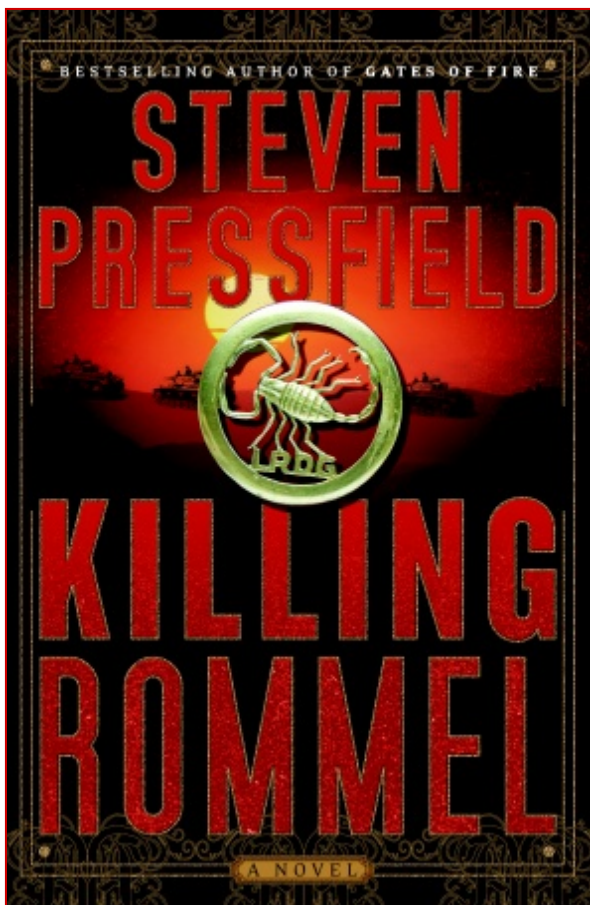

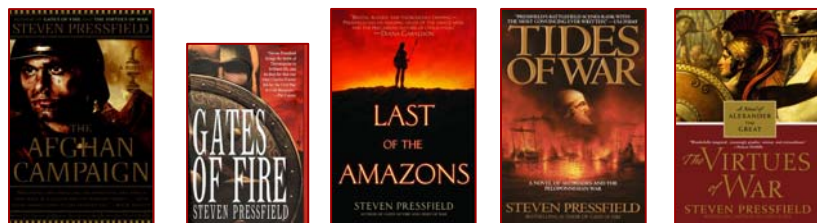

The British hatch a desperate plan—send a small, highly mobile force behind German lines to stop the Afrika Korps in its tracks. *Killing Rommel* brings to life the flair, agility, and daring of this extraordinary secret unit, and chronicles the tactics needed for combat under extreme desert conditions. And it captures the camaraderie of this "band of brothers" crucial to the Allies' victory in North Africa.

Steven Pressfield renders the intensity of warfare and the surprising human emotions that come into play on the battlefield. A vivid depiction of the desert war, *Killing Rommel* brilliantly dramatizes an aspect of World War II that hasn't been in the limelight since *Patton*.
