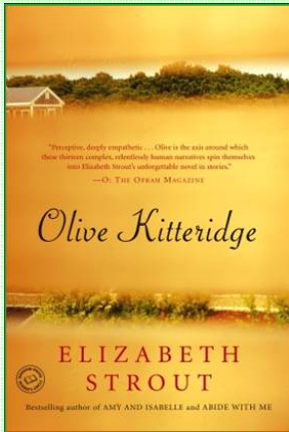

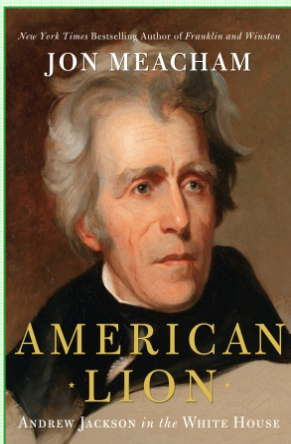

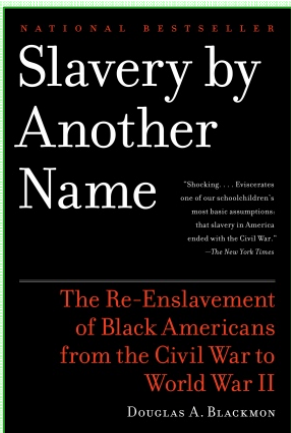
## PULITZER PRIZE FOR BIOGRAPHY *American Lion* by Jon Meacham
