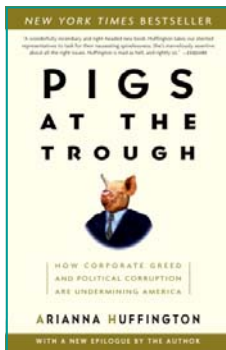

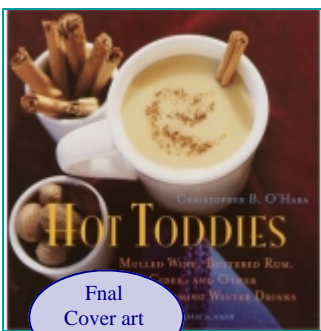

## Hot Toddies Deck

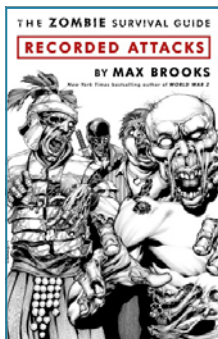

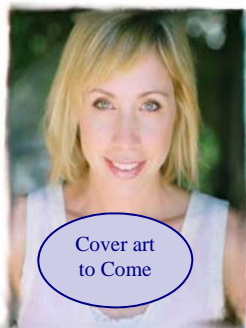


## The Zombie Survival Guide: Recorded Attacks

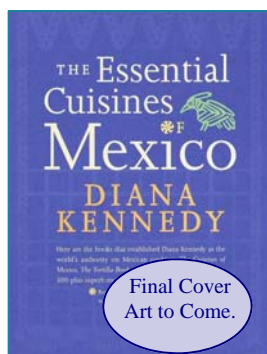
## Pets Who Want to Kill Themselves

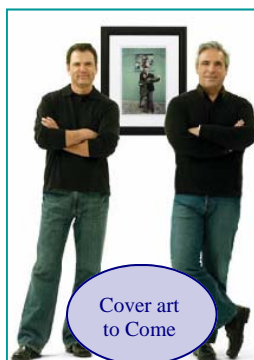
